MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Al Hazelton ("Hazelton"), by his attorneys and pursuant to Section 1.46(c) of the Commission's Rules, hereby moves for an extension of time in which to oppose the Motion to Enlarge Issues against Al Hazelton filed by Stephen O. Meredith on January 13, 1994. In support thereof, Hazelton states as follows.

The Motion, though filed on January 13, was not delivered by the Postal Service to counsel for Hazelton until January 19, 1994. Both January 19 and January 20 were days in Washington, D.C. in which weather and utility problems resulted in disruptions to normal activities, including the early closing of the Commission on January 19 and a complete closing on January. These disruptions and other problems with communications, resulting from the adverse weather, delayed review of the pleading by counsel and the applicant.




