9 JUDGE CHACHKIN: After volume IV we'll take a
10 luncheon recess. After you've identified volume IV we'll take
11 a luncheon recess.

12 MR. SCHONMAN: All right, the following documents

5 JUDGE CHACHKIN: All right, Mr. Emmons, did you have
6 a chance to look at the deposition?

7 MR. EMMONS: Yes, Your Honor, and in light of Your
8 Honor's ruling admitting paragraphs one through three of
9 S.A.L.A.D. Exhibit 17 Trinity would like to have admitted the
10 cross examination that pertains to that witness which is
11 S.A.L.A.D. Exhibit number 6.

12 JUDGE CHACHKIN: S.A.L.A.D. Exhibit 6 which was
13 previously rejected is now received.

14 (The document previously marked for
15 identification as S.A.L.A.D. Exhibit
16 6 was entered into evidence.)

17 JUDGE CHACHKIN: Mr. Honig, I afforded you and your
18 associate an opportunity to review the documents I rejected.
19 If there are any other instances where it was request to cover
20 events of an organization which were not granted or some
21 dialogue with the station which were not granted --

22 MR. HONIG: Yes, Your Honor.

23 JUDGE CHACHKIN: -- I'll consider that.

24 MR. HONIG: I'm not certain whether Your Honor
25 considers Commissioner Carlton Moore of the City of Fort

1 Lauderdale to be for the purposes of this proceeding an
2 individual or an organization. If Your Honor treats a city
3 commissioner as he would an organization then paragraph four
4 of his declaration, portions of his declaration have already
5 been admitted. Paragraph four might also be admitted.

6 JUDGE CHACHKIN: You say portions of his declaration
7 have already been admitted?

8 MR. HONIG: Yes, portions of Mr. Moore's declaration
9 are already in evidence and this, I'm speaking of a paragraph
10 that was previously rejected.

11 The first and second paragraph and the sixth
12 paragraph were admitted and --

13 JUDGE CHACHKIN: What exhibit is this?

14 MR. HONIG: This is S.A.L.A.D. Exhibit 18.

15 JUDGE CHACHKIN: And this is, what exhibit are you
16 looking for?

17 MR. HONIG: S.A.L.A.D. Exhibit 18 and, of which only
18 paragraphs one, two and six are now in evidence and I'm
19 speaking now of paragraph four.

20 JUDGE CHACHKIN: That he's never been contacted in
21 regard to programming?

22 MR. HONIG: Yes.

23 JUDGE CHACHKIN: I'm not going to receive that.

24 MR. HONIG: Okay. There are two other exhibits on
25 behalf of, of presidents of organizations. One of them is

1 Exhibit 20 which is Mr. Soto's declaration.

2 JUDGE CHACHKIN: He states there that a
3 representative of S.A.L.A.D. did appear on Channel 45.

4 MR. HONIG: Yes. Paragraph three speaks of himself
5 as chairman, and then paragraph four then speaking of this one
6 representative amplifies on paragraph three, that he is not
7 here and knows of only one instance where a representative of
8 S.A.L.A.D. appears and then he describes that instance.

9 JUDGE CHACHKIN: I'm not going to reconsider that.

10 MR. HONIG: Okay, and the other exhibit is
11 S.A.L.A.D. 22. This is the exhibit of William Thompson, the
12 president of Hope, Incorporated. And, in which he testifies
13 was, was not contacted by the station and no one appeared.

14 JUDGE CHACHKIN: Well, the point I was making, if
15 there had been requests of one of these organizations to cover
16 an event or to carry a spot on behalf of the organization and
17 was turned down, that was the type of instances I was talking
18 about.

19 MR. HONIG: Oh, okay, well then that would not apply
20 to this exhibit.

21 JUDGE CHACHKIN: No. It wouldn't apply to this
22 where he did not appear. Apparently only one other station of
23 all the stations did have him on a program according to his
24 testimony, so I'm not going to reconsider that, either.

25 MR. HONIG: Okay.

1 JUDGE CHACHKIN: All right, then we can recess now.

2 MR. COHEN: Could we, could we have until a quarter
3 of, Your Honor.

4 JUDGE CHACHKIN: Yes, yes.

5 MR. COHEN: Thank you.

6 JUDGE CHACHKIN: That's 1:45.

7 (Whereupon, the proceedings were recessed from 12:30
8 p.m. to reconvene at 1:45 p.m. later that same day.)
