
On Wednesday, January 19, 1994, representatives of U S WEST, Inc. and U S WEST NewVector Group, Inc., met with Myron Peck, Deputy Chief, Mobile Services Division, to discuss issues addressed in the above-captioned proceedings. The discussion included reference to certain points raised in U S WEST's filings in those proceedings. U S WEST also discussed issues related to the cellular separate subsidiary rules set forth at 47 C.F.R. Sub-section 22.901, focusing particularly on the benefits to be derived from the elimination of the cellular resale restriction applicable to the Bell Operating Companies.
