Filed herewith, in triplicate, is the response of Albany Television, Inc. to the letter sent out on June 22, 1987 from Keith A. Larson, Chief, Low Power Television Branch, Video Services Division, Mass Media Bureau.

Specifically, Albany Television, Inc. is here providing an affidavit from its counsel, James E. Stokes, Jr., verifying that the corporation expended \$10,000 in preparing, filing and prosecuting its application, and a statement from Steven D. Kent, director of Albany Television, Inc., explaining that circumstances beyond Albany Television, Inc.'s control prevented construction prior to its agreement to assign W23AC to the Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. On this point, Mr. Kent explains that Albany Television, Inc. lost access to its designated tower site, and as the Commission knows, such a loss requires the major change of a permittee's construction permit, something which is not routinely permitted.

Accordingly, the substance of the attachments here provided by Albany Television, Inc. establish that it has expended nearly three times the amount of money it will be reimbursed for under its sales agreement with the Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. and that delays in processing, and the loss of its tower site, were circumstances beyond its control, and such circumstances warrant approval of assignment in accordance with Commission rule 73.3535.

In 1983 we, the company, applied for the permit, financing was widely available for this innovative broadcast operation. Tower space was committed and people were committed to going forward with the venture.

However, due to the inordinate length of time between application and selection, a number of tied up details and commitments have gone by the wayside. Tower space at the height originally obtained has been leased to others. Negotiations with current tower owners were fruitless. The cost of reversing this is beyond current owners ability. Financing and capital has been diverted to other ventures by the stockholders and the banks.

During the past few months we have diligently tried to obtain new financing and additional capital, but to no avail. The tower problem and the loss of enthusiasm are the two main culprits.

Nevertheless, Trinity Broadcasting Network Inc. has for many months sought ownership of the unit and finally the stockholders determined, in order to serve the community, the permit should be sold.



On June 1, 1987 the Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. (TBN) filed its license application (FCC Form 347) for LPTV facility W67BG, Dover, Delaware. This letter is intended to supplement that submission by reporting that the AM condition specified in the original W67BG construction permit (BPTTL-830104TF) has been fully complied with.

Specifically, prior to construction of the W67BG tower standard broadcast station WKEN, Dover, Delaware was notified in order that it might determine operating power by the indirect method and request temporary authority from the Commission to operate with parameters at variance with its license, if necessary. Moreover, the required partial proofs of performance were also completed. Telecommunications Consultant Richard S. Arsenault, B.Sc., 2073 Fairton Road, Millville, New Jersey 08332 was commissioned by TBN to perform those tasks.

While some reradiation in WKEN's nighttime directional pattern occurred, it was alleviated by grounding the transmission line on the W67BG tower just above the isocoupler to the tower base just above the base insulator, and by installing a housed detuning network at the tower base which was tied to the ground system. Upon completion of this work it was determined that no adverse effect had occurred to WKEN's array.

Accordingly, TBN respectfully submits that it has fully complied with W67BG's AM condition, and its license application is ripe for grant.


