We will eventually hold rallies and other meetings at which offerings will be received in cities where we hold a license to broadcast.

An appeal for the support of our ministry will be made in November, 1980 during a telethon of Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. Trinity assists several Christian ministries during its telethons and we will be included this year. As soon as we are on the air, we will solicit public support over UHF stations licensed to us.

The organization was formed to provide Christian television programs over UHF channels throughout the United States. Applications have been filed with the Federal Communications Commission for licenses to broadcast in St. Louis and Dallas. The applications are being made pursuant to new F.C.C. rules which make additional UHF channels available.

Wherever a license is granted, we will install earth satellite receiving equipment as well as translator equipment. Through the use of this equipment, we will receive Christian television programs by satellite and broadcast same to the cities where we are licensed. In addition, in each location we will develop and broadcast local Christian programs.

We anticipate licenses will be granted for the St. Louis and Dallas areas in 9 months and that we will be in operation 12 months thereafter. We are preparing applications for San Francisco, San Antonio and Kansas City.

At the present, we are negotiating for equipment and antenna sites, as well as for the necessary equipment. We will be prepared to commence construction as soon as the F.C.C. acts.

The programs will range from evangelistic to those encouraging public support for the poor.

TO LETTER OF INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE
DATED JANUARY 7, 1980

- 1 and 2. The corporation will initially broadcast only satellite-transmitted programs of Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. As soon as possible, we hope to develop local programming in each station. A description of the programming of Trinity is attached. It is anticipated that our local programming will represent the same variety in terms of denominational emphasis as well as format. Local programming will be broadcast on a cost sharing basis, ie., any charge for same will be computed on the basis of our costs.

The corporate president periodically hosts the Praise The Lord evening program of Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. He will therefore appear over our translator stations. He will receive no compensation as a result of such appearances.

We are free to broadcast satellite fed programs other than Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. but have no plans to do so in that no other broadcaster provides Christian programs twenty-four hours each day.

3. Our programs will be limited to religious programs. We will not solicit or broadcast commercial advertising. We will be supported by contributions.

We anticipate entering contracts for local religious programs in areas where our facilities are located. The charges for such programs will be on cost sharing basis.

Trinity Broadcasting Network, Inc. will be a major user of our facilities. Their financial relationship has not been formalized. It is anticipated, however, that our relationship with Trinity will be on the basis as Trinity's present relationship with other broadcasters of satellite fed programs, ie., the programs will be provided and broadcast without charge by either party.
