

cable companies. Many in the tri-state area are looking forward to Paul and Jan to come to the area for a revival.

Michael Giardina reported on the Italy station. Many new viewers have become interested in the ministry. The Italian government has provided an opportunity to expand the outreach of the station through a larger transmitter that would enable the station to reach all of northern Italy, or 6 million persons.

Dale Osborn reported that support for the Canton station is growing. Progress is being made to upgrade the transmitter and to broadcast from a tower providing access to Akron. Viewership is increasing. A public report will begin soon. His Hand Extended has provided assistance to ten families. The station has been dropped by two cable operators. One person per day on the average is receiving Christ.

Mr. Thompson reported on the New York station. Giving has increased approximately 20% this year. Cost sharing receipts have also decreased. Costs have been reduced also. His Hand Extended has served over 1600 persons this past year. The corporation won its labor discrimination suit this year. Two cable systems have been lost. Efforts to restore service are underway, including a letter published in a newspaper. A demonstration program is in place in a local prison.

Mr. Cocnce reported on the operation of the Tri-State network. Numerous salvation reports are coming in.

In Miami, 700 to 1200 people are cared for each month by His Hand Extended. From 3500 to 4000 pieces of clothing are distributed each month. A very solid group of prayer partners is in operation. A large percentage of calls are conversions or rededications. In February, the mortgage for the station will be paid in full.

Mr. York reported that the area is on the verge of a revival. Billy Graham will be in the city this year. Denver is a battleground for various cults. The studio is now producing Doug Clark and Marilyn Hickey programs. The studio set should be completed in 30 days. Local praise programs will be broadcast. Prayer lines are operating from 9:00 a.m. to midnight.

Paul Gray and Jim Fuller reported on the Washington station. Mr. Grey reported that the station is still being carried on all local cable systems. Closed circuit cable systems are targeted for programming. To date, 2200 people have called on local telephone lines reporting salvation or rededication. The station has 150 prayer partners.

The President commended Mr. Gray for his outstanding efforts in working with those who manage cable television systems. Mr. Hollon pointed out that the Washington station has demonstrated the potential for putting corporate programs on hospital television systems.

The presence of John Des.Casoria, Pastor of Trinity Christian Center, was noted by the President. Pastor Des.Casoria gave a report on the status of the church. He previously served as interim pastor for 18 months. When he returned in 1986 there were 30 to 40 persons attending. Every Sunday, someone receives Christ or is healed. Seventy-five families have come in recently. There are approximately 350 attendees each Sunday. Special meetings for senior citizens occur weekly.

The congregation is almost entirely brand new.

Pastor Des.Casoria will receive his Ph.D. in a few months in education.

Pastor Des.Casoria continues to serve as President of Community Educational Television.

A telethon was recently conducted in Harlingen, with a satellite feed to Beaumont also.. The Houston station is in process and should be the hub of the CET operations.

The boards considered a policy for a leave of absence that will not exceed four months, depending upon the merits of the situation. In all circumstances two medical statements verifying the disability will be required.

The President noted that Arthur Gilbert Manger of our Nevis station was unable to be present. He is working on a permit for St. Lucia.


Al Brown could not attend due to weather conditions that barred flights out of Oklahoma City.
