
Dear Mr. Miller:

National Minority Television, Inc. (NMTV) has been successful in receiving a grant to operate K36CJ from Ensign Peak. Thank you for your permission last year to file the application.

Enclosed please find a copy of the Construction Permit and technical data sheets relating to the proposed equipment. Our methodology is rather simplistic. We receive our signal via satellite, pass it thru a 1KW transmitter and broadcast thru our Bogner antenna. We will need someone to maintain and monitor our signal on a daily basis but this can be arranged when construction is commenced. We would like a five (5) year lease with a couple of five (5) year options with lease fee tied to the Consumer Price Index for Utah. We will pay our own electricity.
