MASS MEDIA BUREAU'S MOTION TO DELETE
LANGUAGE FROM THE HEARING DESIGNATION ORDER

1. On February 1, 1994, the Commission released its Hearing Designation Order and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing for Forfeiture, FCC 94-23 (HDO), in which it designated for hearing The Lutheran Church/ Missouri Synod's applications for renewal of licenses of Stations KFUE/KFUE-FM. For the reasons which follow, the Mass Media Bureau hereby requests that certain language in the HDO be deleted.

2. At paragraph 35, the HDO erroneously references Section 1.91(c) of the Rules concerning when a notice of appearance in this case should be filed. Section 1.91 of the Commission's Rules, however, applies to revocation proceedings and cease and desist orders. It does not apply to renewal proceedings such as the instant one. It is therefore requested that the Presiding Judge delete from the HDO references at paragraph 35 to Section 1.91(c).


3. Also at paragraph 35, the HDO erroneously references

Section 1.92(c) and (d) of the Rules concerning waiver of the licensee's right to a hearing. Section 1.92 (c) and (d), however, also relate to revocation proceedings and cease and desist orders. These sections, like Section 1.91(c), do not apply to renewal proceedings. It is therefore requested that the Presiding Judge delete from the HDO references to Sections 1.92(c) and (d) and the language in paragraph 35 predicated on the deleted sections (i.e., the last sentence of paragraph 35).
