ORDER

Adopted: February 14, 1994 Released: February 14, 1994

1. On July 19, 1993 the Bureau released an Order,¹ designating issues in our investigation of the 800 data base access tariffs. That order set deadlines by which oppositions to the local exchange carriers' (LECs) direct cases had to be filed. On August 5, October 18, and November 30, 1993 and January 4, 1994, the Tariff Division released orders, each of which extended the time for filing pleadings responding to the LECs' direct cases. Currently, replies are due on February 15, 1994 and rebuttals are due on February 28, 1994. On February 9, 1994, the Ad Hoc Telecommunications Users Committee (Ad Hoc) filed a motion to extend the time for filing comments until thirty days following the filing of the LECs' complete direct cases.

2. Several LECs filed petitions for waiver of the cost disclosure requirements of paragraph 29 of the *Designation Order*.² On January 31, 1994, the Bureau released an order denying those petitions for waiver. Ad Hoc contends that interested parties need an extension of time, until thirty days after the LECs complete their direct cases, to permit them to review that additional information and prepare their responses.

3. The Division has reviewed Ad Hoc's request for an extension of time and has determined that good cause has been shown to grant an extension to all parties. Therefore,



price cap LECs that wish to file additional cost support or arrange for the release of their cost models under protective agreements must do so by March 15, 1994. Given the length of time this proceeding has been pending, we anticipate granting no additional time for parties to provide all information requested in this proceeding. Oppositions or comments on direct cases will be due on April 15, 1994. Rebuttals to oppositions or comments will be due on April 28, 1994.

4. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the petition for extension of time filed by Ad Hoc Telecommunications Users Committee IS GRANTED, to extend the deadlines for all parties in this proceeding to file revised cost support, arrange for the disclosure of their cost models or file pleadings responding to direct cases, and rebuttals, as specified in paragraph 3 of this Order.
