Dear Mr. Stewart:

On behalf of Ruth Communications Corporation ("Ruth"), permittee of WRWX(FM), Sanibel, Florida, I hereby request the Commission to expedite completion of the referenced rulemaking proceeding to change the allotment of Channel 253A from Sanibel to San Carlos Park, Florida.

This rulemaking has been ripe for decision for more than two years. Prior to filing the rulemaking, the petitioner acted diligently, since its construction permit was granted in 1986, to construct the station. For reasons wholly beyond Ruth's control, which are fully documented in Ruth's pleadings, it is impossible for Ruth to construct a station allocated to Sanibel.

The only objection to the proposed rulemaking was filed by a competitor, Sunshine Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of Station WSUV, Fort Meyers Villas, Florida.

Based upon status inquiries of the Commission staff, Ruth understands that this proceeding was removed from active consideration several months ago at the direction of the Bureau Chief's Office. Whatever reason there may have been to defer this matter does not justify further

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continued delay which results in the public being denied the service which Ruth intends to provide if the re-allocation is granted.

In the event the Commission believes some additional factual or legal showing is required, Ruth will provide such a showing upon request.

Accordingly, Ruth Communications Corporation respectfully requests the Commission to conclude the pending rulemaking as quickly as possible.
