PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Audrey R. Morris, Petitioner in the above-captioned proceeding, by her attorney, hereby petitions for an extension of time through and until May 12, 1994, in which to file her application for a construction permit for Channel 262A at Atlantic Beach, South Carolina. In support thereof, the following is shown.

On December 13, 1993, the Commission released a Report and Order in the above-captioned proceeding (DA 93-1374) granting Ms. Morris' petition to reallocate Channel 253A at Pawley's Island, South Carolina to Channel 262A at Atlantic Beach, South Carolina as that community's first local aural transmission service and the modification of Ms. Morris' construction permit to specify Atlantic Beach as its community of license.^{1/}

Ms. Morris filed her petition for rule making on June 25, 1992, and specified a hypothetical location based on an existing tower then believed available to her. Shortly after release of the Report and Order granting Ms. Morris' petition, she sought

reasonable assurance of the availability of the hypothetical tower site and was advised that it was no longer available to her. Subsequent inquiries to the owners of other existing tower sites that would meet the Commission's coverage and minimum separation requirements indicated that these sites were not available as well. Accordingly, Ms. Morris is now attempting to obtain reasonable assurance of the availability of land on which a new tower can be constructed. Several potential sites have been identified and Ms. Morris is proceeding with negotiations with the owners of these sites.

For the foregoing reason Audrey R. Morris respectfully requests an extension of time through and until May 12, 1994, in which to file her application for a construction permit for Channel 262A at Atlantic Beach, South Carolina.


