GENERAL REGULATIONS

(N)

A. APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This tariff applies to communications services furnished by Capitol Radiotelephone Company, Inc. dba Capitol Paging dba Greenbrier Paging (hereinafter referred to as "Company") between its base radiotelephone stations and subscriber mobile (radiotelephone) units and pagers within all or parts of the following West Virginia Counties:

Kanawha, Wood, Raleigh, Monroe, Myer, Logan, Williamson, Boone, Fayette, Mercer, Lincoln, Wayne, Cabell, Putnam, Clay, Mason, Jackson, Boone, Wirt and Ritchie.

B. REGULATIONS

1. Definitions

Domestic Public Land Mobile Radio Service - A public communications service, for hire, between mobile (radiotelephone) stations and base radio stations, or between two mobile stations, or from base stations to pagers which includes the following:

Dispatch Communications - Communications normally of not more than one minute duration, between landline telephones and mobile (radiotelephone) stations or between two such mobile (radiotelephone) stations. (N)

General Communications - Communications between mobile (radiotelephone) unit and landline telephone or between mobile units.

Signaling Communications - One-way tone and voice communications from base stations to mobile receivers or pocket receivers (pagers).

Service Area - The entire area surrounding the land radiotelephone stations of Carrier within which satisfactory communications can be initiated and maintained between the land radiotelephone stations and subscribers units in such area and as generally shown on the service area maps contained in this tariff.

2. Availability of Service

Signaling communications service is available to any person using paging and/or radiotelephone units equipped for this service 24 hours each day when within the service area of the Company, subject to transmission, atmospheric and like limitations except that radiotelephone service within the Beckley service area is available only to established radiotelephone service accounts and current radiotelephone service access numbers. 3. Provision of Terminal Equipment

Terminal equipment and maintenance thereon may be provided by Company* or may be supplied and maintained by the customer. Customer-provided equipment shall meet reasonable Company requirements and shall be maintained in a manner reasonably suitable to Company.

* The PSC of West Virginia has no regulatory jurisdiction over terminal equipment.

Terminal equipment is to be maintained in accordance with all pertinent FCC regulations for the type service involved. Capitol Radiotelephone reserves the right to refuse service to any customer unit which has not been maintained such as to comply with current FCC regulations governing the affected service.

4. Undertaking of Company

The obligation of Company to furnish service is dependent upon its ability to secure and retain suitable facilities and rights for maintenance of the necessary circuits and the construction of the necessary equipment.

- c. The Company shall not be liable for any defacement of or damages to the premises of a Customer or Subscriber, resulting from the furnishing of service, which is not the result of the Company's negligence.
- d. Except when a court of competent jurisdiction finds that gross negligence, willful neglect, or willful misconduct on the Company's part has been a contributing factor, the liability of the Company for any claim or loss, expense or damage (including indirect, special or consequential damage) for any interruption, delay, error, omission, or defect in any service, facility (including services and facilities involved in emergency calling activity)

or transmission provided under this tariff shall not exceed an amount equivalent to the prorata charge to the Customer or Subscriber for the period of service or facility usage during which such interruption, delay, error, omission or defect occurs. For the purpose of computing this amount, a month is considered to have thirty (30) days.

7. The subscriber shall pay Company the applicable charges specified in this tariff and the applicable charges specified in any applicable tariff of any other telephone company participating in any part of the service.

8. Advance Payments

The amount of the advance payment is credited to the subscriber's account on the first bill rendered under the account.

9. Deposits

Company may, in order to safeguard its interests, require an applicant or a subscriber to make a suitable deposit in conformance with the rules and regulations for the government of Telephone Utilities, Section 2.02, to be held by it as a guarantee of the payment of the charges made. The fact that a deposit has been made in no way relieves the applicant or subscriber from complying with applicable regulations with respect to advance

payments and prompt payment of bills on presentation. At such time as the contract is terminated, the amount of any deposit still held by Company shall be credited to the subscriber's account and any credit balance shall be refunded.

10. Initial Contract Period and Termination of Service by Subscriber and Company.

- a. The initial contract period for service is one month.
- b. After the initial contract period, service may be terminated at any time by the subscriber upon receipt by Company of written notice, subject to payment of full charges for the period service is rendered, except that, if termination occurs within the initial contract period, charges apply for the full initial contract period. Company, at its sole discretion, may accept oral notice of termination in lieu of written notice.
- c. Service or facilities may be terminated by Company, at any time after subscriber has been given notice as required by the PSC of West Virginia, where the subscriber:

(1) fails to timely pay the Company any charges due applicable under this tariff and not in bona fide dispute; or,

2. Miscellaneous

a. Returned Check Charge

If a check or draft which is presented to the Company for payment for services provided is not honored by the financial institution upon which it was written, the following additional charge shall apply:

b. Special Arrangements

The Company may, for charitable purposes, enter into special arrangements with its customers for the provision of radio common carrier services. The charges applicable to such arrangements shall be no less than the approximate incremental cost of providing such services.

b), following, in response to any communication from a subscriber requesting the elimination of charges for such calls made by the subscriber.

(a) Governmental fire fighting, police and emergency squad services, as designated by the appropriate governmental agency, qualify as governmental emergency service agencies provided they answer emergency service calls on a personally-attended (live) twenty-four (24) hour basis, 365 days a year, including holidays. Calls to "911" qualify for free airtime.

(b) An emergency is an occurrence or set of circumstances in which conditions pose immediate threat to human life and/or property and necessitate that prompt action be taken. An emergency call is an originated call of short duration to a governmental emergency service agency in order to seek assistance with such an emergency.

(2) The Company will provide all customers with a toll-free telephone number which customers may use to notify the company that an emergency call has been placed.


