Pursuant to the requirements of Sections 1.1200 et seq. of the Commission's Rules, you are hereby notified that on behalf of McCaw Cellular Communications, Inc. ("McCaw"), Gerard Salemme, Senior Vice President - External Affairs, Howard J. Symons of Mintz, Levin, Cohn, Ferris, Glovsky and Popeo, P.C. and myself met late yesterday with Gregory J. Vogt, Chief of the Tariff Division, and Judith D. Argentieri and Barbara Esbin of the Common Carrier Bureau. The issues discussed at the meeting concerned the rulemaking referenced above and included: 1) McCaw's view regarding the need to choose a single model for any equal access obligation imposed on wireless carriers and the need to uniformly apply such a requirement to all CMRS providers; 2) the advantages of the current system of individually negotiated contracts between LECs and Part 22 providers when compared to a requirement that LECs tariff all interconnection rates; and 3) its view that CMRS providers' right to interconnect to the local exchange network ensures interoperability of CMRS networks and abrogates any need to promulgate additional CMRS interconnection requirements.
