ORDER

Issued: April 4, 1994 ; Released: April 6, 1994

By Public Notice dated February 25, 1994, "FCC Freezes Comparative Proceedings," FCC 94-41, the Commission suspended and held in abeyance the processing of applications and the adjudication of hearing proceedings which involve a comparative analysis. This action was taken in light of the Opinion of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia in Bechtel v. FCC, 10 F. 3rd 875 (D.C. Cir. 1993). In its Public Notice, the Commission further directed the Chief Administrative Law Judge to appoint settlement judges, who will have the authority to convene conferences for the applicants to explore the possibility of voluntary settlements conforming to Commission policy.

Accordingly, pursuant to the Commission's Public Notice, "FCC Freezes Comparative Proceedings," IT IS ORDERED, That Administrative Law Judge Joseph P. Gonzalez is hereby appointed to serve as the Settlement Judge in this proceeding.
