

PETITION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND

ASF Broadcasting Corporation ("ASF"), by its attorneys, hereby submits its petition for leave to amend its above-captioned application. In support hereof, the following is submitted:

It appears that the broadcasting assets previously owned by Mid-Ohio Communications, Inc. ("Mid-Ohio"), former licensee of radio station WBBY, have been sold to an entity known as Spirit Communications, Inc ("Spirit"). As noted on the attached amendment, Ardeth Frizzell, ASF's principal, has been verbally advised that Spirit is willing to lease those assets in a manner similar to that offered by Mid-Ohio. At this time, ASF has no information whether the price will be identical. No written confirmation has yet been received, although it has been promised.

Technically, this may not be an amendment to the application, since it does not change any of the information contained therein. However, it is being filed in the interest of keeping the application up-to-date, as required by the rules.


To the extent this is considered an amendment, it was not caused by ASF's voluntary action, it is being filed with due diligence, and no party will be unfairly prejudiced.

ASF Broadcasting Corporation hereby amends its pending application for a construction permit for a new FM broadcast station at Westerville, Ohio, to report as follows:


