ORDER



By Order, FCC 94M-272, released April 19, 1994, the Chief Administrative Law Judge designated the undersigned to serve as the Settlement Judge in this proceeding. Pursuant to that appointment an informal settlement conference SHALL BE HELD on May 12, 1994, commencing at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission's Washington, D.C., offices.

In order to make the settlement conference as productive as possible, counsel ARE DIRECTED: (a) to assure that their clients are cognizant of the decision in Bechtel v. FCC, 10 F.3d 875 (D.C. Cir. 1993), the Commission's Public Notice, "FCC Freezes Comparative Proceedings," FCC 94-41, released February 25, 1994, and the Commission's statement that "the final resolution of the issues raised by Bechtel may take some time, . . ."; (b) to confer with their clients and discuss in detail the advantages and disadvantages of settlement; and (c) to confer informally with opposing counsel, at a time and in a manner agreeable to all, for the purpose of exploring the possibility of reaching a settlement. At the settlement conference, counsel shall be prepared to report on and discuss their clients' positions on settlement and the results of the informal meeting among counsel.
