On behalf of the Personal Communications Industry Association, I want to thank you for the opportunity to have participated in the April 11-12, 1994, panel discussions on new Personal Communications Services (PCS), conducted by the Federal Communications Commission's PCS Task Force.

You are to be commended for your leadership and vision in initiating such an unprecedented approach to the regulatory rulemaking process. The hearings provided a dynamic means for public interaction with the Commission. The resulting dialogue served to clarify the issues before the Commission in the PCS docket and to comprehensively review the extensive record in the proceeding. Moreover, the day and a half of public debate broke the seemingly endless cycle of individual *ex parte* presentations which have occurred over the past months, and makes clear that the issues are ripe for final resolution.

I must also express PCIA's appreciation for the unequivocal and clear statement, delivered by the hearing, that the agency intends to move forward rapidly with informed, final decisions on the pending reconsideration petitions in the present docket.

The hearings provide a culmination to more than four years building a record on licensing new, broadband PCS services. The Commission is clearly poised to bring the deliberative process to a close and make new PCS a commercial reality in the United States.
