 - Enables Bidders to Uncover Any “Bugs” or Problems in the Software
 - Establishes that the Software Matches the Commission’s Auction Rules
 - Assists Bidders in Familiarizing Themselves with the Bidding Process
 - Bidding Software Should be Provided Free of Charge, But in Copyrighted Form for Non-Commercial Use Only
