MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Adopted: June 10, 1994; Released: June 15, 1994

By the Acting Chief, Tariff Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. On May 2, 1994, the Southern New England Telephone Company (SNET) filed Transmittal No. 610 to revise its Tariff F.C.C. No. 39. SNET proposes adding one additional telephone company central office to the list of central offices where it will offer expanded interconnection service. SNET states that the purpose of this filing is to respond to a bona fide request from a customer for expanded interconnection service in the West Hartford 01 central office, located at West Hartford, Connecticut. Description and Justification at 1-2. No petitions were filed against this tariff. Transmittal 610 is scheduled to take effect on June 16, 1994.

2. This transmittal raises the same issues regarding cost allocations, rate levels, rate structures, and terms and conditions of service as those identified in the Expanded Interconnection Tariff Order.¹ Therefore, Transmittal No. 610 is suspended for one day, until June 17, 1994, and will be subject to the investigation initiated in the Expanded Interconnection Tariff Order. These rates will also be subject to an accounting order to facilitate any refunds that may later prove necessary.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 204(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, 47 U.S.C. § 204(a), and Section 0.291 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.291, the revisions to SNET Tariff F.C.C. No. 39,


Transmittal No. 610, ARE SUSPENDED for one day and an investigation of the referenced tariff transmittal IS INSTITUTED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SNET SHALL FILE tariff revisions within five business days of the release date of this Order to reflect this suspension.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, for these purposes, we waive Sections 61.56, 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 61.56, 61.58, and 61.59. SNET should cite the "DA" number of the instant Order as the authority for this filing.

6. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 204(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, 47 U.S.C. § 204(a), SNET shall keep accurate account of all amounts received by reason of the rates that are the subject of this investigation.
