COMMISSION RESPONDS TO CONGRESSIONAL INQUIRY

On May 3, 1994, the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations of the Committee on Energy and Commerce wrote to the Commission's General Counsel asking for a response to twelve questions related to the Commission's implementation of its pioneer's preference rules in certain proceedings involving personal communications services.

On June 3, 1994, the General Counsel responded with two letters. The first letter answered the Subcommittee's questions related to the Commission's narrowband PCS proceedings. The second letter answered the Subcommittee's questions related to broadband PCS proceedings.
