
This letter concerns your pending request for authority to remain silent. Temporary authority is hereby granted for the above-referenced station to remain silent through January 30, 1993.



Gentlemen:

Cavan Communications Corporation, the licensee is Station WTMS(AM), Presque Isle, Maine, respectfully requests the reinstatement of its authority for the station to remain silent. This request is filed in response to your letter of February 18, 1993 with regard to the fact that the previous authority had expired. The letter requested additional information as to the status of the licensees; efforts to return to the air.

As the Commission's records will reflect, Station WTMS(AM) was forced to go silent when the company encountered financial problems in northern Maine and the loss of revenues. At that time, the licensee's effort was directed to maintain the operation of its sister station WTMS(FM).

Since the station has been off the air Cavan Communications Corporation has made continuous and ongoing efforts to find a purchaser for both stations. In late January, 1993 Four Seasons Communications, Inc., a multiple radio station owner and the owner of station WBPW(FM) in Presque, Maine, initiated negotiations to complete the sale purchase of both station WTMS(AM) and (FM). A memorandum of understanding for the sale of the stations has been exchanged between the parties and an agreement and sale of the facilities is contemplated within the next 45 to 60 days. It is the intent of the new owners to return the facility to operation as quickly as possible.

In the meantime, while station WTMS(AM) has been silent the licensee has continued to maintain its power lighting on its equipment and other maintenance repairs to insure the station can return to operation with minimum effort.






