**Re: Notice of oral ex parte presentation
GN Docket No. 93-252**

Dear Mr. Caton:

On July 20, 1994, the American Mobile Telecommunications Association, Inc. (AMTA) made an oral ex parte presentation concerning the above-captioned docket to Mr. Rudolfo Baca, Attorney Advisor to Commissioner Quello. The matters discussed included the lack of clear, contiguous spectrum for wide-area 800 MHz Specialized Mobile Radio (SMR) services, and the need for such spectrum should wide-area SMR be regulated comparably with cellular service. AMTA has made a wide-area bloc licensing proposal to the Commission in its Reply Comments in this proceeding.

Also discussed was the overwhelming opposition in the record of the above-captioned proceeding to a proposed Commercial Mobile Services (CMRS) spectrum aggregation cap. AMTA also indicated its support of the proposed reorganization of the Commission to create a Wireless Services Bureau.
