On July 21, 1994, the American Mobile Telecommunications Association, Inc. (AMTA) made an oral ex parte presentation concerning the above-captioned docket to Mr. Ralph Haller, Chief of the Private Radio Bureau; Ms. Beverly Baker, Deputy Chief; and Mr. David Furth, Acting Chief of the Rules Branch. The matters discussed included the need for clear, contiguous spectrum for wide-area 800 MHz Specialized Mobile Radio (SMR) services should wide-area SMR be regulated comparably with cellular service. AMTA has made a wide-area bloc licensing proposal to the Commission in its Reply Comments in this proceeding.

Also discussed was the overwhelming opposition in the record of the above-captioned proceeding to a proposed Commercial Mobile Services (CMRS) spectrum aggregation cap.
