
July 28, 1994	-	Mr. Kilbourne

Counsel for Four Jacks has agreed to take the deposition of Ms. Covington in Baltimore at a law office to be designated by Four Jacks.¹

Ms. Barr and Ms. Covington are to be informed that their deposition and hearing testimony shall be sequestered. Since they are in regular contact about the health of Ms. Covington's spouse and the general programming at WMAR-TV, Ms. Barr and Ms. Covington should refrain from discussing any substantive aspect of this case until after the hearing testimony of Scripps Howard is completed.
