

- **CMRS Spectrum Cap**
 - **45 MHz Cap**
 - **ESMR licenses will be counted to have less than 10 MHz because of the non-contiguous spectrum assignments (ESMR licensees will be able to present facts to the Commission to demonstrate a lesser amount).**
 - **Statement that Nextel will be eligible to participate in all 30 MHz PCS broadband auctions**

- **Contiguous Block License on an MTA Basis**
 - **Adopted by August 10, 1994**
 - **Mandatory retuning of non-ESMR licensees to create contiguous block of exclusive use spectrum on Channels 401-600**
 - **Single MTA license requiring no individual site approval**
 - **Mandated time line for issuance of block licenses within one year**
