This is to advise you that on July 15, 1994, Pacific Telecom Cellular, Inc., filed a Section 402(a) Petition for Review in the District of Columbia Circuit of the FCC decision: In the Matter of Amendment of the Commission's Rules to Establish New Personal Communications Services, FCC 94-144, released June 13, 1994.

Challenge to the PSC Order, in which the Commission adopted and amended certain rules governing the regulation of broadband personal communications services and the method and manner of allocation of radio frequency licenses. The Commission also established rules amending Part 24 of Title 47 of the code of Federal Regulation, arbitrarily limiting the eligibility of entities that hold a non-controlling investment interest in a cellular operator to participate in PCS licenses.

Due to a change in the Communications Act, it will not be necessary to notify the parties of this filing.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 94-1507 and the attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is James Carr.
