CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Missouri State Conference of Branches of the NAACP, the St. Louis Branch of the NAACP and the St. Louis County Branch of the NAACP (collectively "NAACP") respectfully requests that the date for filing Findings and Conclusions be extended from August 26 to September 2, and that the date for filing Reply Findings and Conclusions be extended from September 19 to September 28.

The approval of the Executive Director of the National NAACP is required for the filing of a major brief in a licensing case. On Saturday, August 20, the NAACP Board of Directors named Earl Shinhoster as the Acting Executive Director. Mr. Shinhoster has not had an opportunity to review the history of the case and to determine that the draft brief is consistent with NAACP policy. He has just assumed office and has inherited a number of urgent and regrettable crises which are matters of public record. It will be virtually impossible for him to review the matter this week.

All counsel have graciously consented to this motion, and the appropriate §1.46(c) notification has been provided.
