**REPORT AND ORDER  
(Proceeding Terminated)**

Adopted: October 4, 1994; Released: October 13, 1994

By the Acting Chief, Allocations Branch:

1. At the request of Muscatine Communications, Inc. ("petitioner"), the Commission has before it the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 9 FCC Rcd 2193, (1994), proposing the allotment of Channel 226A to Muscatine, Iowa, as the community's second local commercial FM transmission service. Petitioner filed comments reiterating its intention to apply for Channel 226A, if allotted to Muscatine. No other comments were received.

2. We believe the public interest would be served by the allotment of Channel 226A to Muscatine, since it would provide the community with an additional local aural transmission service. Channel 226A can be allotted to Muscatine in compliance with the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements with a site restriction of 4.8 kilometers (3.0 miles) south in order to avoid a short-spacing with the licensed site of Station KATF(FM), Channel 225C1, Dubuque, Iowa.<sup>1</sup>

3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective **November 28, 1994**, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED, with respect to the community listed below, to read as follows:

City	Channel No.
Muscatine, Iowa	226A, 259C1

4. The window period for filing applications will open on **November 28, 1994**, and close on **December 29, 1994**.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
