COMMENTS

Integrated Broadcasting Company, Inc. ("Integrated"), licensee of Station KTHK(FM), Okmulgee, Oklahoma, by its counsel, hereby submits its comments in support of the Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("NPRM"), 9 FCC Rcd 4882 (1994) proposing, inter alia, to substitute Channel 231C1 for Channel 231C2 at Okmulgee and to modify the license for Station KTHK(FM) accordingly. Integrated hereby reaffirms its interest in applying for Channel 231C1 if allotted and in constructing the upgraded station if authorized to do so.

1. In response to a joint petition submitted by Integrated and KRIG, Inc., licensee of Station KRIG(FM), Nowata, Oklahoma, the NPRM also contemplated the substitution of Channel

286C3 for 232A at Nowata, the modification of Station KRIG's license to specify Channel 286C3 and the substitution of Channel 280A for vacant Channel 285A at Pawhuska.

2. Integrated was served with comments from Rhema Media expressing an interest in applying for Channel 285A at Pawhuska. Integrated submits that the proposed substitution of Channel 280A at Pawhuska should offer to Rhema Media the same opportunity as Channel 285A for serving Pawhuska. Rhema Media did not indicate why Channel 280A was unacceptable.

3. In this regard, Integrated notes that on October 19, 1994, the Commission announced an application window filing period for Channel 285A at Pawhuska which is set to expire on November 22, 1994. See Exhibit 1. Based on whether an application is actually filed on or before November 22, 1994, the Commission can decide whether to substitute Channel 280A or delete Channel 285A without substitution if no applications are filed. The Commission's Public Notice did indicate that Channel 280A is proposed for substitution at Pawhuska in this docketed proceeding. Thus, interested parties could comment on the comparative merits of the proposed upgrades at Okmulgee and Nowata versus the retention of Channel 285A (instead of Channel 280A) at Pawhuska.

4. Integrated urges the Commission to approve its requested upgrade to Channel 231C1 for KTHK as set forth in Option I of the NPRM. If the Commission is not able to grant


the concomitant upgrade of KRIG, then Integrated would support Option II or Option III in the NPRM which modifies KRIG's license to specify Channel 285A at Nowata. In that event, Integrated reaffirms that it will reimburse Station KRIG for the reasonable costs in changing its channel.

5. Accordingly, Integrated reaffirms its interest in the proposed upgrade of its station to Channel 231C1 as set forth in Option I of the NPRM. Integrated will apply for the upgrade and construct if authorized to do so.
