

On November 8, 1994, David Gusky, Executive Director of the National Cellular Resellers Association ("NCRA") and the undersigned counsel to NCRA met with Karen Brinkman, Assistant to Chairman Hundt, regarding the above-referenced dockets. Matters discussed included the question of the interconnection obligations of cellular resellers to permit resellers to attach their own switch to the facilities of cellular carriers, the status of the petition for reconsideration filed by NCRA in Docket No. 93-252, and anticipated action by the Commission on the question of monitoring cellular rates and its further consideration of interconnection and equal access issues pending in Docket No. 94-54.
