JOINT REPORT ON THE RESULT OF SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATIONS

The Chief, Common Carrier Bureau (Bureau), on behalf of the parties of record, hereby submits a report on the status of settlement negotiations in the captioned proceeding.

1. On September 19, 1994, the presiding Administrative Law Judge granted a consent motion to stay all procedural and filing dates for 60 days to allow sufficient time for the parties to pursue settlement discussions. Although negotiations are continuing amongst some of the parties, discussions to date have not resulted in any definitive agreement amongst all parties. Certain parties, however, have reached tentative agreements between themselves and expect to be filing the agreements with the Commission shortly.

2. Because settlement discussions to date have not resulted in a comprehensive agreement, and no agreement appears likely in the near future, the parties have decided to proceed with the hearing. The tentative agreement reached between certain parties does not affect the need for a

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
hearing on the designated issues. The parties will be meeting to address a new hearing schedule and propose to file a joint motion for the establishment of new procedural dates on December 2, 1994.

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
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
