1. On November 22, 1994, Community Educational Association ("CEA") filed a Motion for Summary Decision of the following issue:

To determine whether CEA is a qualified educational organization proposing an acceptable educational format in compliance with 47 C.F.R. Sec. 73.503(a) of the Commission's Rules.

The Mass Media Bureau supports CEA's motion.


2. On October 13, 1994, CEA petitioned for leave to amend its application in order to include a statement regarding CEA's purpose and how CEA will advance its educational program. The amendment was accepted by Order released October 25, 1994 (FCC

In our view, CEA has shown that it is a qualified educational organization proposing an acceptable educational format.
