ORDER

Issued: December 13, 1994 ; Released: December 15, 1994

This office is in receipt of a Joint Motion for the Acceptance of New Procedural Dates, filed by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Telephone and Data Systems, Inc. and United States Cellular Corporation, on December 12, 1994, on behalf of all parties of record.¹

The procedural dates established for this proceeding, by Order, FCC 94M-169, released March 17, 1994, and Order, FCC 94M-432, released on July 7, 1994, were suspended at the request of all parties of record, by Order, FCC 94M-534, released on September 19, 1994, on the joint representation that settlement negotiations were ongoing which would, if they proved successful, obviate the need for a hearing. The Presiding Judge was subsequently advised by Joint Report on the Result of Settlement Negotiations, filed with this office on November 16, 1994, that the Parties had not been able to reach a comprehensive settlement which would render a hearing unnecessary. Accordingly, they advised the Presiding that they would be submitting a joint motion for the establishment of new procedural dates.

The Motion described above is presently before us. Good cause having been shown, it will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED, that the Joint Motion for the Acceptance of New Procedural Dates, filed by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Telephone and Data Systems, Inc. and United States Cellular Corporation, on December 12, 1994 IS GRANTED, and the following procedural dates will govern the resolution of the issues designated by the Commission in the *Memorandum Opinion and Order and Hearing Designation Order* (FCC 94-29), released on February 1, 1994:

- December 29, 1994 - The date for filing the Bill of Particulars.
- February 3, 1995 - The date the parties will submit their direct case or a statement as to what will be established by oral testimony at the hearing.
- February 10, 1995 - The date for the exchange of lists of witnesses requested for cross-examination.
- February 17, 1995 - The date for filing oppositions to witness requests.
- March 7, 1995 - The date for the Admissions Session which will commence at 10:00 a.m. in the offices of the Commission in Washington, D.C.
- March 14, 1995 - The date for the commencement of the hearing which will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the offices of the Commission in Washington, D.C.
