Dear Mr. Caton:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules, notice is hereby given of an *ex parte* communication regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

Today, Richard E. Wiley of this firm and Mimi W. Dawson, Policy Advisor for Wiley, Rein & Fielding met with Commissioner James Quello and Mr. Rudolfo M. Baca, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Quello, to discuss Pinpoint's views in this proceeding. They reiterated Pinpoint's commitment to work for solutions and underscored Pinpoint's belief that the decision in this proceeding should continue to provide for wide-area AVM systems to have access to shared spectrum.

In this respect, they noted that Pinpoint is willing to time share with other wide-area AVM providers. Pinpoint is also willing to share spectrum with local-area systems as demonstrated by its testing with Amtech. Moreover, Pinpoint has recently filed a proposal with the Commission under which it could operate without a wideband forward link in shared spectrum without protection from interference from Part 15 operation. While operation without protection from Part 15 interference and without its wideband forward link would not be Pinpoint's preferred mode of operation, Pinpoint is willing to take such steps in order that shared access to the band by wide-area AVM might be preserved.
