Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules, notice is hereby given of an *ex parte* communication regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

Today, Richard E. Wiley of this firm and Mimi W. Dawson, Policy Advisor to Wiley, Rein and Fielding, met with Commissioner James Quello and Mr. Rudolfo M. Baca, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Quello, to discuss Amtech's views in this proceeding. They urged the Commission to continue to maintain non-exclusive spectrum in the 902 - 928 MHz band and noted that Amtech has explained that its technologies can share spectrum with other users of the band as illustrated by Amtech's testing with the wide-area AVM technology developed by Pinpoint Communications.
