

DECLARATION OF DONALD E. WARD

I am the sole proprietor of the Law Offices of Donald E. Ward (formerly Donald E. Ward, P.C.), and was retained by Rivertown Communications Co., Inc., in the summer of 1991 to represent it in the preparation and filing of its application for a construction permit for a new FM broadcast station in Eldon, Iowa.

Rivertown's application was filed in early October 1991; a competing application was filed by Sample Broadcasting Company, L.P. The applications were designated for comparative hearing on December 30, 1992. Prior to designation, Rivertown filed (on April 14, 1992) a Petition to Deny the Sample application, and (on July 10, 1992) a Petition for Leave to Amend, each of which was opposed by Sample, to which oppositions Rivertown replied.


Following designation, both applicants petitioned for enlargement of issues, and oppositions and replies were filed. Discovery was conducted through depositions of the applicants' principals in Eldon, Iowa, on April 1-2, 1993, and an additional deposition was taken in Washington in May 1993.

Hearings were held in Washington on June 22 and 23, 1993. Proposed Findings and Reply Findings were filed by both parties. Rivertown filed a Petition to Enlarge Issues in September 1993, which Sample opposed, and to which Rivertown replied. Following the November 1993 release of the Initial Decision granting Sample's application and

denying Rivertown's application, we prepared and filed Rivertown's Exceptions and Brief, and responded to the Contingent Exceptions of Sample.

I personally prepared each of the pleadings filed on behalf of Rivertown in this proceeding; conducted the depositions and hearing on its behalf; and assisted its principals in the preparation of Rivertown's hearing exhibits. Through September 30, 1994, we have billed Rivertown a total of \$57,694, of which \$3,554 was for reimbursement of actual expenses incurred on behalf of Rivertown (principally transcripts, travel, and lodging), and \$54,140 was for services, based upon our customary hourly rates. Of this total amount of \$57,694, Rivertown has paid this firm \$37,776.

The foregoing declaration is true and correct, and is given under penalty of perjury.


