REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Antelope Broadcasting Co., Inc., the permittee of KYHT(FM), Yermo, California, by its attorneys, pursuant to FM Channel and Class Modifications by Application, 8 FCC Rcd 4735, 4740 (1993) hereby requests the withdrawal of its rule making petition seeking to substitute FM Channel 287B1 for FM Channel 287A at Yermo, California, and a modification of the authorization for KYHT(FM) to specify operation on Channel 287B1. Antelope Broadcasting Co., Inc. is submitting its proposal in the form of a one-step upgrade application pursuant to Section 73.3573(a)(1) of the Commission's rules. An FCC Form 301 application seeking a construction permit for Channel 287B1 is being filed this day.



I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this _____ day of December, 1994.


