ORDER

Adopted: December 27, 1994

By the Chief, Office of Engineering and Technology:

1. On October 20, 1994, the Commission adopted a Notice of Proposed Rule Making (NPRM) in the above-captioned proceeding.<sup>1</sup> The specified deadlines for comments and reply comments were December 19, 1994, and January 3, 1995, respectively. On December 21, 1994, the Part 15 Coalition filed a Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Reply Comments with the Commission in the above-captioned proceeding. The Part 15 Coalition requests that the reply comment date be extended to January 6, 1995. By this Order we are extending the reply comment date.

2. In its Motion, the Part 15 Coalition urges that the reply comment date be extended by several days due to the importance of the proceeding, the large number of comments received, and the interruption of normal business activities during the holiday season. The Part 15 Coalition points out that many businesses are closed for the entire last week of December and that most are closed on January 2, 1995, which is a national holiday. Therefore, the Part 15 Coalition argues that it will be unable to receive input from many of its members and be prepared to file adequate reply comments by January 3, 1995.


3. If we are to develop a complete record, it is important that all parties be provided sufficient opportunity to consider the large number of comments received and to develop

substantive reply comments. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT the deadline for filing reply comments in response to the Notice of Proposed Rule Making IS EXTENDED to January 6, 1995. This action is taken pursuant to authority found in Sections 4(i) and 303 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Sections 154(i) and 303, and pursuant to Sections 0.31, 0.241, and 1.46 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Sections 0.31, 0.241, and 1.46.
