MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials-International, Inc. ("APCO"), by its attorneys, hereby requests that the Commission extend the deadline for filing reply comments in the above-captioned proceeding until March 20, 1995.

APCO, the National Emergency Number Association ("NENA"), and the National Association of Nine One One Administrators ("NASNA") filed Joint Comments in response to the Commission's Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, and intend to file joint reply comments. Initial comments were also filed by over 100 other parties, who submitted a total of over 1,500 pages of detailed information.

APCO, NENA and NASNA are reluctant to seek additional time for reply comments as they are anxious to resolve the issues in this proceeding. However, these and other public safety groups also feel a special responsibility to


