

Escrow Funds, together with all interest accrued, to Solo in the manner set forth herein.

(e) Payment or delivery by the Escrow Agents of the Escrow Fund under this Paragraph 2 shall be made as follows:

(1) If to Solo, at Solo's direction by bank check made payable to Solo Music Company, Inc. or by wire transfer of funds to such account as Solo shall direct in writing.

(2) If to PDB, at PDB's direction by bank check made payable to PDB Broadcasting Company, and delivered to such account as PDB shall direct in writing.

(f) It is understood that should any dispute or controversy arise with respect to the Escrow Fund or disbursement thereof, the Escrow Agents are authorized and directed to retain in their possession, without liability to anyone, all or any part of said Escrow Fund until such dispute shall have been settled either by mutual agreement by the parties concerned or by the final order, decree or judgment of a court or other tribunal of competent jurisdiction in the United States of America and time for appeal has expired and no appeal has been perfected, but the Escrow Agents shall be under no duty whatsoever to institute or defend any such proceeding.

3. Performance. The duties and responsibilities of the Escrow Agents are limited to those specifically set forth herein and the Agents need not take notice of any provisions of

the Joint Agreement. The Escrow Agents shall not be liable for any mistake of fact or error in judgment made in good faith or for any acts or omissions by it of any kind other than willful misconduct or gross negligence. The Escrow Agents shall be entitled to rely, and shall be protected in doing so, upon, (1) any written notice, instrument or signature believed by it to be genuine and to have been signed or presented by the proper party or parties duly authorized to do so; and (2) the advice of counsel (which may be of Escrow Agents' own choosing). The Escrow Agents shall have no responsibility for the contents of any writing submitted to it hereunder and shall be entitled in good faith to rely without any liability upon the contents thereof.

4. Indemnification. Solo and PDB, jointly and severally, agree to indemnify the Escrow Agents and hold them harmless against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred by it hereunder, except for liabilities incurred by the Escrow Agents resulting from their own willful misconduct and gross negligence. Without in any way limiting the joint and several nature of such obligations, as between Solo and PDB, each party shall be responsible for the payment of one-half of any such liabilities.

5. Discharge by Delivery. After the Escrow Agents have delivered the Escrow Fund pursuant to the terms of this Agreement the Escrow Agents shall have discharged all of their

obligations hereunder and neither Seller nor Buyer shall thereafter have any claim against the Escrow Agents on account of this Agreement.

6. Resignation of Agents. The Escrow Agents may resign at any time by giving written notice thereof to the other parties hereto, but such resignation shall not become effective until a successor escrow agent shall have accepted such appointment in writing. The successor escrow agent shall be mutually appointed by Solo and PDB; provided, that if an instrument of acceptance by a successor escrow agent shall not have been delivered to the Escrow Agents within thirty (30) days after the giving of such notice of resignation, the resigning Escrow Agent may, at the expense of Solo and PDB, petition any court of competent jurisdiction for the appointment of a successor escrow agent.

7. Conflict. In the event of any conflict between the terms and provisions of this Agreement and those of the Joint Agreement, the terms and provisions of this Agreement shall control.

8. Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon, inure to the benefit of, and be enforceable by the respective successors and assigns of the parties hereto.

9. Entire Agreement; Amendments. This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and may be amended only by a written

instrument duly executed by all parties hereto.

10. Notices. All notices, requests, demands, and other communications required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given when delivered personally (which shall include delivery by Federal Express or other recognized overnight courier service that issues a receipt or other confirmation of delivery) to the party whom such communication is intended, or three (3) business days after the date mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

or to such other address as such party shall specify by written notice to the other parties hereto. Any notice served upon the Escrow Agents shall also be sent to all other parties.

11. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, without regard to the conflict of law rules utilized in that jurisdiction.

12. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed simultaneously in one or more counterparts each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

13. Continuing Effect. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until the Escrow Agents have delivered the Escrow Fund and any other instruments held by it pursuant to this Agreement in accordance with the terms hereof.

14. Headings. Paragraph headings contained herein are for reference only and shall not in any way affect the meaning or interpretation of this Agreement.

Dear Mr. Pennington:

I am writing to you on behalf of our client, Solo Music Company, Inc., in connection with the Erath/Woodville matter.

As you and your client may be aware, Solo has determined for the time being to build its C-3 operation, upon approval by the FCC, at its existing licensed location. It is anticipated that the application, which has been on file for some time, should be granted within the next 30 days.

Solo is well aware that the best of plans often go astray for reasons beyond their control. Solo also appreciates the fact that your client has incurred certain time and expense in the prior negotiations. Accordingly, Solo proposes that it enter into an option arrangement with your client as follows:

- (1) Upon the execution of the option, Solo would pay to your client \$2,500.00, which would be nonrefundable.
- (2) From the date of the execution of the option for a period of one year, Solo would have an option to require your client to execute the Joint Agreement that you previously prepared and sent to me by letter dated October 18, 1992.
- (3) If the option is exercised, then the payments to your client will be made as contained in your draft and the \$2,500.00 option payment would be applied to the \$10,000.00 total figure.




