On February 10, 1995, Roy Neel, President & CEO of USTA, Peter Knight and Gary Epstein met with Chairman Hundt, Karen Brinkman, Donald Gips, Kathleen Wallman, Richard Metzger and others from the FCC. The topic of the meeting was the relationship of telecommunications to education; and particularly the educational initiatives being undertaken at the FCC. Because some commentors in the price cap docket made educational proposals, CC Docket 94-1 was briefly discussed. Mr. Neel's comments in this regard were consistent with USTA's filed position in this docket. In addition, on February 13, Mr. Neel met with Kathleen Wallman, Richard Metzger, and others from the FCC's Common Carrier Bureau to discuss the LEC price cap plan.
