On behalf of Southwestern Bell Mobile Systems, Inc. an original and one copy of this notice is being filed pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules out of an abundance of caution to report certain telephone discussions between Martin D. Liebman of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Louis Gurman and Nadja S. Sodos of this office on February 21, 1995. The conversations concerned the Report and Order, Amendment of Part 90 of the Commission's Rules to Adopt Regulations for Automatic Vehicle Monitoring Systems, FCC 95-41 (released February 6, 1995).
