Logicon is considering an investment in Celsat America, Inc., which has an interest in the referenced proceedings. By way of background, Logicon is a public NYSE listed company in the defense electronics and software business. We have been in business since 1961, and at the close of our fiscal 1994 posted revenues of \$320 million, profit of \$21 million, a net worth of \$98 million, and a very strong balance sheet.

Having examined Celsat America's business plans, and based upon a general knowledge of the MSS potential and competitive situation, Logicon believes that the allocation of 70 MHz of new spectrum for the MSS is strongly in the public interest. We believe that, used in this manner, the spectrum will permit the extension of Cellular and PCS services to all of the United States at an affordable price. We are also convinced that this is the best means of obtaining "Enhanced 911" services along with its resultant savings of lives.

Finally, we are firm believers in competition. As a result, we feel that this new spectrum should be made available only to applicants who have no MSS licenses.
