


DEAR COMMISSION:

I AM IN THIS BUSINESS FOR THE PAST 35 YEARS AND I HAVE NOTHING AGAINST "NEW TECHNOLOGY". HOWEVER, I AM AGAINST THE COMMISSION HANDING OUT PRIVILEGED RIGHT TO LICENSEES AND MANUFACTURERS TO HAVE MONOPOLY RIGHT ON ANY TECHNOLOGY.

THE RADIO WAVES ARE A PUBLIC RESOURCE AND NOT TO BE DEALT OUT TO PRIVILEGED FEW TO MAKE A MONOPOLY. TO USE "NEW TECHNOLOGY" ON A PUBLIC RESOURCE MUST BE SHARED WITH OTHERS.

AS AN EXAMPLE, WE HAVE MOTOROLA COMMUNICATIONS USING THEIR TRUNKING TECHNOLOGY, THAT IS ABOUT 20 YEAR OLD, AS A MONOPOLY. IF THE COMMISSION IS SET ON GIVING MORE MONOPOLY RIGHTS TO MOTOROLA THEN I AM AGAINST ALL OF THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION PROPOSALS. THE COMMISSION SHOULD MAKE A CHOICE, EITHER TO SERVE MOTOROLA OR THE PUBLIC NEED. RIGHT NOW THE COMMISSION HAS AN OBSESSION IN MAKING A DOLLAR FOR THE GOVERNMENT THAT WAS NEVER PROVIDED FOR IN THE ORIGINAL COMMUNICATIONS ACT, AND NOW CLOUDS ALL ISSUES.
