This letter is submitted on behalf of TRW Inc. ("TRW"), a recently awarded licensee in the mobile satellite services (File Nos. 20-DSS-P-91(12), CSS-91-015, 17-SAT-LA-95, 18-SAT-AMEND-95).

The Commission's decision to evaluate the allocation of additional spectrum in the 2GHz bands for mobile satellite services, and the terms on which such additional spectrum is to be allocated, is of critical importance to TRW. In this regard, TRW believes that in order for the Commission to receive comments of maximum utility to the agency's decision-making process, a more realistic time schedule should be adopted for the submission of comments and reply comments in this proceeding.

Accordingly, TRW supports the motion for extension of time filed on February 22, 1995 by American Mobile Satellite Corporation to allow for the filing of comments by May 5 and
