DECLARATION

I, Terry H. Schroeder, hereby declare as follows:


1. I am the Vice President of Scripps Howard Broadcasting Company ("Scripps Howard"), an applicant for renewal of license of television station WMAR-TV, Channel 2, Baltimore, Maryland (File No. BRCT-910603KX). Scripps Howard has entered into a settlement agreement with Four Jacks Broadcasting, Inc. ("Four Jacks") which contemplates the dismissal of Four Jacks' mutually exclusive application for a construction permit for a new television station on Channel 2 at Baltimore, Maryland, and the grant of Scripps Howard's renewal application for WMAR-TV, contingent on favorable resolution of certain outstanding basic qualifications issues.

2. Scripps Howard considers the settlement agreement to be in the public interest because it will facilitate the resolution of the hearing case between the Four Jacks and Scripps Howard applications, thereby simplifying the Commission proceeding. DECLARATION

I, David D. Smith, hereby declare as follows:

3. Four Jacks certifies:


(a) That it did not file its application for a construction permit for the purpose of reaching or carrying out this agreement or any other settlement.
