900 MHz Phase II Talking Points

Incumbent Licensees:

- a. **Protected Sites** - All sites licensed, or subject to pending application, as of August 10, 1994.
- b. **Flexibility** - Add, subtract, move, and modify sites without FCC prior approval, as long as 22dbu contour of protected sites is not expanded.
- c. **Loading** - Requirements are eliminated.

MTA Licensee:

- a. **Operating Area** - Anywhere within MTA, but sites cannot be located within 70 miles of incumbent's protected sites or 70 miles of the DFA border.
- b. **Flexibility** - Add, subtract, move, and modify sites without prior FCC approval as long as no co-channel interference is caused to incumbents and contiguous MTA licensees.
- c. **Coverage Requirement** - 1/4 of the population of the MTA in 3 years.
1/3 of the population of the MTA within 5 years.
- d. **Loading** - No loading requirement.
- e. **Incumbent's Prior Waivers** - Existing waivers for incumbent licensees extended to MTA licenses acquired by incumbents, e.g. foreign ownership.

Auction Rules:

- a. 20 licenses per MTA. Licenses with an incumbent are identified by license holder's name and contact telephone number.
- b. Frequency specific applications are accepted for all licenses at the same time. Any license for which there is only one applicant will not be auctioned.
- c. Licenses to be auctioned in blocks of MTAs, corresponding to a geographical region.

- d.** Designated entity preferences only on unencumbered licenses.*
- e.** Designated entity credits not to exceed 25%. Small businesses defined as per the small business rules of the Commerce Department.*
- f.** Deferred payment provisions available to designated entities and to incumbents on licenses which extend their existing license. *
