

On April 14, 1995, John O'Rourke, Rory Van Tuyl, and Cynthia Johnson met on behalf of Hewlett Packard ("HP") with Mary McManus, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Susan Ness, to discuss the Commission's proposal to permit use of radio frequencies above 40 GHz. In addition to matters addressed in HP's comments in ET Docket No. 94-124, HP expressed its support for the development of a band sharing plan that would accommodate both satellite systems and LMDS systems in the 28 GHz band.
