

On April 14, 1995, John O'Rourke and I met on behalf of Hewlett Packard ("HP") with Scott Harris, Cecily Holiday, Fern Jarmulnek, and Jennifer Warren, of the International Bureau, to discuss the Commission's proposal to permit use of radio frequencies above 40 GHz. In addition to matters addressed in HP's comments in ET Docket No. 94-124, HP expressed its support for the development of a band sharing plan that would accommodate both satellite systems and LMDS systems in the 28 GHz band.
