

On April 13, 1995, Scripps Howard and Four Jacks filed a Joint Request for Extension of Time in which these parties requested additional time until April 21, 1995, to address a Bureau objection to a portion of a pending Settlement proposal. It is represented in the Motion that the Bureau does not object to the extension of time.
